All services are provided by professional oncology social workers and are offered completely free of charge.

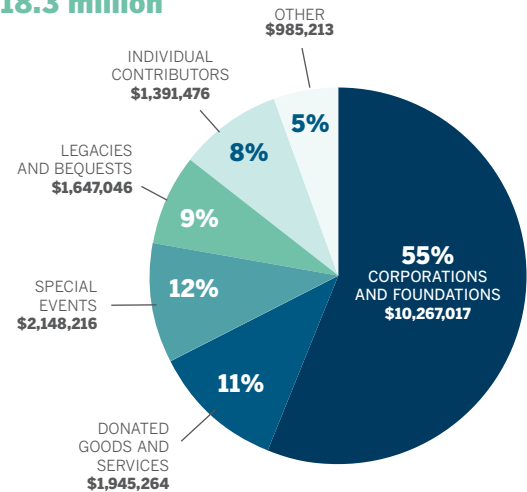

- Welcomed 1 million unique visitors to our website

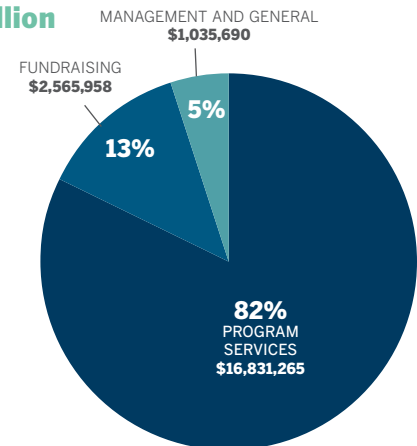
