CancerCare's Online Support Groups

CancerCare's online support groups connect patients, caregivers, and the bereaved with their peers for shared support, camaraderie, and knowledge. Each group is moderated by a professional oncology social worker with the aim of creating a confidential and safe environment for all members. Each new member is personally screened by a CancerCare social worker to ensure that they are subscribed to an appropriate group that will meet their needs. All groups are free of charge, password-protected and only available to subscribed group members.

Aspects and Benefits of CancerCare's Online Support Groups:

- Free of charge
- Available 24/7 for reading and posting messages
- Moderated by professional oncology social workers
- "Bulletin-board" message format, not a chat room
- All group members are screened prior to joining
- Groups are private, subscription-only forum
- Time-limited format (3.5 months per session)
- Accessible from the privacy and comfort of your own home
