CancerCare's Bladder Cancer Transportation Program is currently available to help provide financial, emotional and practical support for people living with bladder cancer who are in active treatment.

TYPES OF CARE COVERED

- Financial assistance for eligible individuals to pay for transportation-related costs such as gas, taxis, Uber or Lyft and public transportation
- Resource referrals to help address needs resulting from bladder cancer
- Emotional and practical support from CancerCare oncology social workers
- Educational information to help manage the emotional and logistical challenges of living with cancer

The financial assistance component of the program will continue until all available funds are disbursed.
