## Cancer Care Co-Payment Assistance Foundation Income Audit Policy

The Cancer Care Co-Payment Assistance Foundation is happy to be able to offer applicants a speedy review by offering an electronic income verification process. However, as a charity that provides co-payment assistance, we need to adhere to certain federal guidelines and regulations. Therefore as stated in our <u>Applicant Declaration and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) Authorization form</u>, we have the right to request that your reported financial income be verified by an audit.

If selected to comply with our income audit, the applicant is required to submit a signed copy of the current year **US Federal Income Tax Return** (IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ).

For individuals who **do not** file an Income Tax Return, they must submit the following for both the applicant and spouse if applicable:

- A copy of your most recent Social Security/Disability Award Letter, Benefit Statement or monthly check
- A copy of your W-2
- A copy of all other income statements that may be applicable to your specific situation (pensions, annuities, taxable interest income/dividends, business income, rental income)
- A copy of your Unemployment Check or Benefit Notification

Once requested, documents need to be received within 60 days. If documents are not received during the allotted time, the assistance will be terminated until the information is received and reviewed.
