CancerCare ofrece un grupo de apoyo en vivo gratuito de 12 semanas para personas que hablan Español diagnosticadas con cáncer en Nueva York que están recibiendo una forma de tratamiento activo (que puede consisten en cirugía, quimioterapia, radiación, tratamientos hormonales y/o tratamiento de cáncer avanzado). Este grupo proporcionará un lugar seguro para intercambiar apoyo, obtener información y recibir orientación mientras discutiendo los desafíos únicos de vivir con un diagnóstico de cáncer.

Weekly Live Support Group

A diagnosis of cancer can come when you least expect it. Suddenly your world has changed. You may feel overwhelmed and anxious and have questions about what lies ahead. The opportunity to connect with others living with cancer can help you feel less alone.

DESCRIPTION

CancerCare is offering a free, 12-week live support group for Spanish-speaking people diagnosed with cancer in New York who are receiving a form of active treatment (which may consist of surgery, chemotherapy, radiation, hormonal treatments and/or advanced cancer treatment). This group will provide a safe place to exchange support, get information and receive guidance while discussing the unique challenges of living with a cancer diagnosis.
