Living with Loss: Single Parents Bereavement Support Group **Weekly Support Group**

The loss of a loved one can be a very difficult time. You may find yourself experiencing feelings of sadness, anger, frustration and confusion. Our bereavement support group for single parents provides a safe space to connect with others who have experienced the loss of a loved one due to cancer and are actively parenting.

DESCRIPTION

Cancer*Care* is offering a free, 12-week live support group for people in New York who have experienced the loss of a loved one due to cancer in the last 18 months and are caring for one or more children under age 18. This group will provide a safe place to exchange support, get information and receive guidance while discussing the unique challenges of grief and loss
