# Child Support Group

For a child, the loss of a loved one can bring about an array of complex feelings. Confusion, sadness, anger, quilt or fear are all common reactions for a grieving child.

For children, these feelings can become intense and overwhelming. Rather than talk about these feelings, you may begin to see subtle changes in their behavior at school or even at home. Having a place for them to connect with other children who are also grieving can be comforting. Through group art, activities and discussion they will see that they are not alone.

Cancer Care is currently recruiting children between the ages of 5 and 12 who have experienced the loss of a loved one to cancer within the last 18 months. This group is led by a professional oncology social worker and will run for twelve weeks.
