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Loss of a Minor Child Support Group

The emotions that follow the loss of a young child to cancer can feel all-consuming for a parent.

These overwhelming and complex feelings may be intense and difficult to experience on your own. The opportunity to join a group of other parents that have faced such a loss—to share your story of love and loss with others who, to a certain extent, understand what you are going through can be very comforting.

CancerCare is currently recruiting parents that are bereaved a minor child (18 years and younger) to cancer. This group is led by a professional oncology social worker and will run for twelve weeks.
