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Life After Cancer *Young Adult Support Group*

Connecting with a group of other 20- or 30-year-olds who are in the same place can make the transition into life after cancer easier to negotiate. The opportunity to talk through the big and the little stuff as you find your groove again may be just what you need.

CancerCare is currently recruiting participants who are young adult survivors (ages 20 to 39) and have completed their cancer treatment within the last 18 months. This group is led by a professional oncology social worker and will run for twelve weeks.
